## **President's Message:**

Hi Club Members.

As I write this report, life around Melbourne has woken up after enduring such a long lockdown. Our Bowls Club is open for business even though we must adhere to a certain level of limitations including the requirement for all members and visitors to be double vaccinated. Playing Bowls is now back to what we are used to, and we look forward to the start of the Pennant season in a couple of weeks. Bowls practice has recommenced and our Wednesday Social Bowls will start on the 10<sup>th</sup> of November. Night Pennant will also start on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> of November. Friday Social Drinks has restarted and it's great to see members enjoying the Club and making use of the bar. The COM has been busy in getting things moving again and I wish to acknowledge all their hard work during our time away from the Club.

Early this month, the Club held a Special General Meeting to vote on a resolution to cancel the Social Deck. I have already advised all club members of the outcome of the meeting and certainly appreciate the support provided to the COM in reinforcing the direction the Club needs to go to be the best Bowls Club we can be. I also acknowledge the right of Club members to query and discuss the decisions that COM makes. We are a volunteer sports club and we want the best for all members. I also would again thank the Social Deck Steering Committee for their hard work for the Club.

The Club has commenced its negotiations with Monash Council re the renewal of our lease and due to the lockdown, the Council is still to provide the first draft of the lease agreement. I hope sure that now we will see some movement with this. We will keep you informed of progress as we move through this important process. With our new deck project underway we would like to renew the appearance of the Clubhouse. This may include modernising the interior, e.g. foyer, improving the outside of the Club and provide furniture and heating for the deck. COM are opening The Clubhouse Project fundraising opportunity and if you would like to support the Club, you can donate directly to the club via direct funds transfer or credit card payment. If you would like a tax-deductible method, you can donate through the Australian Sports Foundation. More details on this are in the newsletter.

We are heading into the busy time before Xmas for the running of our corporate and private functions which generate much needed income for the Club. With the lockdown ending, the Club has been inundated with requests for functions. From the 19<sup>th</sup> of November until late December we already have 13 functions scheduled with more scheduled after New Year. The Club will need your help and support to manage all these events and I will be calling on you to volunteer and provide your time. Volunteering sheets will be provided in the foyer for each event. ## **MWBC Social Deck Update: -**

Following the strong support of members arising from the Special General Meeting, the President sent round in his mid-Oct Club report a copy of the Steering Committee report of 14th Oct and asked for any further input from members. Perhaps you felt you had your say at the SGM because we received only four responses which were mostly supportive.

The Committee of Management (COM) at its meeting on 28th Oct has now signed off on key features of the Social Deck.

COM has taken the view that it is important to have as much flexibility as possible in future configurations of use of the deck and so there will be no central steps in the final design. The rectangular shape of the deck will be relieved by a small 'extended arc' in the centre which will not only provide a prominent viewing area for members but also an area for use on special presentations. Access to shade, shelter and toilets from the centre green will still be convenient - the last via the outside doors - and there will be less need for players accessing the gents toilets to disrupt the bar/lounge area.

The balustrade will take the form of a stainless-steel rail and posts supplemented by s/steel wires, similar to the Frankston deck as illustrated on the notice board. Steps at each end will occupy 50% of the deck width and be complemented at the western end by a compliant disabled ramp.

Final design of the front area and seating will be developed as the detailed drawings are completed.

Last Friday - 29th Oct - the concrete forecourt was given the 'ultrasound treatment' to establish the presence or otherwise of underground services and on Wed 3rd November concrete cutting and soil testing will take place.

The results of this exercise will allow our designer and engineer to begin development of detailed design drawings of the deck.

Watch this space for preliminary design work!

In the meantime, here is a 3-D image of the deck in the proposed form.




#### **Sponsor News**

#### **'THE CLUBHOUSE PROJECT' – APPEAL**

Now that the design phase of our new deck has commenced in earnest, I believe we have a great opportunity to look at renewing and modernising other aspects of the Clubhouse in conjunction with the deck. I am pleased to launch an appeal to raise funds to modernise the interior, eg foyer, improve the outside of the Clubhouse and provide furniture and heating for the deck. This will help create the relaxed outdoor social space we have all been craving for.

We wish to brighten up the foyer area by replacing the old-style wooden fittings, look at either painting or rendering the facade of the Clubhouse, replacing the old curtains in the dining room, painting the internal areas of the Clubhouse, and providing the deck with tables, chairs, sun umbrellas and external heating for the deck.

In launching the appeal, we are setting a target of \$15,000, which we think should be sufficient to help cover the cost of these updates. As previously communicated, no specific decisions on the amount or type of furniture will be made until we have experienced the new deck for a trial period.

I also have pleasure in announcing that we have already received member and sponsor donations to start this fundraising campaign. So, we are on our way towards the target!


Social bowls is recommencing on Wednesday  $10^{\rm th}$  November. Put you name on the list.
