#### Did You Know.....?

The land that the club house sits on was purchased in 1964. The Club also owned land facing onto High Street Road. This were sold in 1967 and the proceeds used to pay for the retaining wall at the back of the clubhouse. The club greens sit on reclaimed land that formed part of the Damper Creek watercourse. The area around Damper Creek would originally have been a valuable source of food for the traditional inhabitants of the area — the Wurundjeri. With a history like that and our modern bar we could well become the Damper Creek Waterhole.

### **Working with Children:**

If you have a working with children's card, it needs renewing after 5 years. You should get a reminder email 28 days before it expires. It is worth checking the date it expires though. Renewal is available online. If you have renewed your working with children, don't forget to let the club secretary know.

### We need to make a better effort!!

Members are reminded that the Dumpster is NOT a receptacle for materials that either MUST or should be recycled.

The following were found in the Dumpster recently:

**1- E-WASTE** — it is illegal IN VICTORIA to send e-waste to landfill. - These items can be sent to Monash Transfer Station - free of charge. This item has now gone to Monash



**2- MAJOR CARDBOARD ITEMS** - can be recycled via the Monash Waste transfer station in Ferntree Gully road - free of charge. This item has now gone to Monash



**3- METAL ITEMS** - where items in usable condition cannot be found a good home in Op-Shops, metal can also be sent to the Monash Transfer Station - free of charge. 50% of these have gone to Op Shops.
