Social Deck

David Rae has now received the final statutory approval for the completion of the Social Deck - the Certificate of Final Inspection from the building surveyor.

Here is a summary of the final social Deck costs:

- Overall cost (ex GST) \$108,167- this includes \$3,000 for the first sketch plan for the Commonwealth grant submission
- Funds received from State Government, Commonwealth Government and Members \$75,650
- Nett cost to Club \$32,517 this represents 15% of the funds the Club received from the winding up of the Southern Indoor Bowling Club. So, no real cost to members funds.
